

## EE Installation Instructions

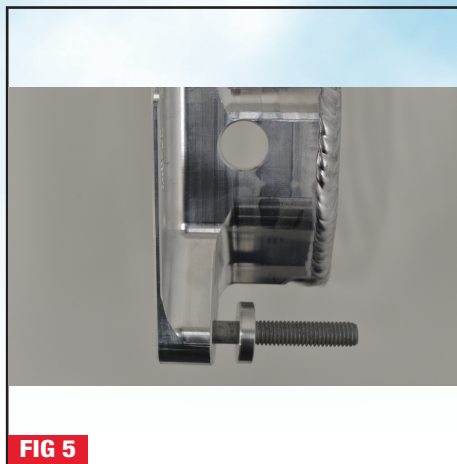

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- 1 Using a 24mm socket remove the axle bolt (fig. 1).
- 2 Using a 10mm socket remove the lower brake caliper mounting bolt (fig. 2).
- 3 Mount the disc guard to the fork leg using the original front axle bolt, only finger tighten at this time (fig. 3).
- 4 Apply some thread locking agent to the threads of the supplied M8x55mm hex head flange bolt that will replace the original caliper bolt from step 2 (fig. 4). **For 2019-Current models use the provided spacer between the disc guard and caliper mount. (Fig 5)** With a 10mm socket lightly tighten the M8x55mm bolt into the lower brake caliper mounting hole (fig. 6).
- 5 Torque both the axle bolt and caliper mounting bolt to the manufacturer's torque specs.
- 6 Have fun and ride safe!
