WARNING AND DISCLAIMER

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- 1 Using a 10mm t-handle or socket remove both of the right side axle pinch bolts. (Fig 1)
- 2 Place the provided spacers between the fork leg and the fork guard as shown. (Fig 2)
- 3 Use the provided longer 8 x 35mm Hex head bolts in place of the original pinch bolts to install the fork guard as shown. (Fig 3)
- 4 Using a torque wrench with a 10mm socket, torque the pinch bolts to the manufacturer's torque specifications. (Fig 4)
