

1. Take note of your handlebar location. We recommend marking the handlebar in the position it is sitting in the lower handlebar mount with a marker. This will insure that when you reinstall them they will be in the same position.
2. Using a 10mm T-Handle or socket or 6mm Allen Wrench, remove the 4 handlebar mounting bolts. Set aside the bolts you will not need them with the riser kit. Keep the top clamps handy. (FIG 1) Some models may require you to remove the plastic caps to get to the bolt heads. (FIG 1.1)
3. Remove the handlebars from the Handlebar mounts.
4. Place 1 or 2 Handlebar risers spacers into each of the bottom handlebar mounts to reach your desired height. (FIG 2)
5. Place handlebars back in the handlebar mounts on top of the riser spacers.
6. Replace the oem top handlebar clamps with the provided bolts in the riser kit. Use the 8x45mm bolt if using 1 spacer. Use the 8x50mm bolts if using 2 spacers.
7. Using a 10mm T-Handle or socket or 6mm Allen Wrench, tighten the bolts installed in step 5 to factory spec. (FIG 3)
8. Have fun and enjoy your next ride. (FIG 4)
