

Skid Plate Installation Instructions

- 1 Remove the stock plastic skid plate.
- 2 Position the EE skid plate so that the front mounting holes in the skid plate align with the factory mounting tabs on the frame. Using the two supplied M6x20 flat head bolts, partially thread them in to the factory mounting tabs. (Fig 1)

***NOTE:** Installation may be easier with the motorcycle laying on its side.

- 3 Working from the right side of the motorcycle with the skid plate hanging low in the back, position the rear clamp (part # 016-02) on to the top of the rear frame rail. Hold the clamp in position by reaching over the rear shock linkage to hold the clamp onto the frame. While holding the clamp in position, push the skid plate up against the frame. Then insert the supplied M8x25 flat head bolts into the rear mounting holes of the EE skid plate and thread them in finger tight. (Fig 2 and 3)

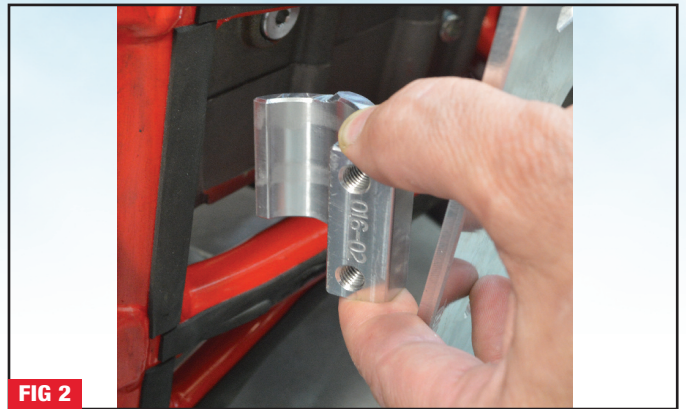

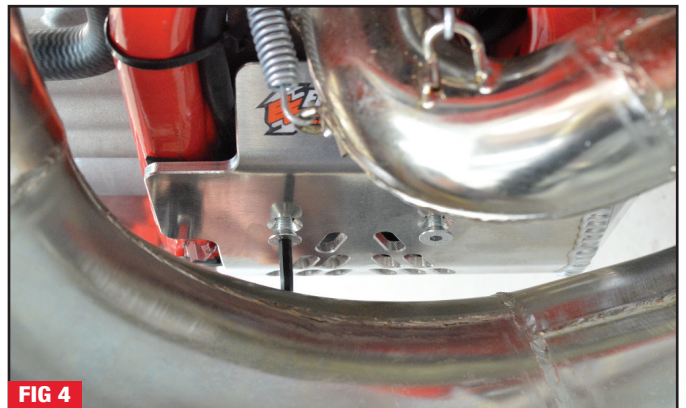
