SKIDPLATE INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Using an 8mm T-Handle or socket, remove the plastic OEM Skidplate. (FIG 1)
- 2. Applying provided foam adhesive to the frame rails.
- 3. Take the provided skid plate hook with the hook facing the back of the skidplate, thread in the two provided flat head 6x20 bolts. (FIG 2) Keep them loose until a later step.
- 4. Line the skidplate up underneath the bike and slide it backwards so the hook goes over the back frame rail of the bike.
- 5. Take the provided M6x16 socket head bolts and thread them into the OEM skidplate mounting location. (FIG 3) Leave loose until later step.
- 6. Slide in the provided skidplate strap behind the frame rails with the part number facing outward and rightside up. The strap will be above the two front engine mounts.
- 7. Thread the provided M8x40 flat head bolts through the skidplate mounting hole and into the skidplate strap. (FIG 4)
- 8. Using a 5mm Allen wrench, tighten the front two mounting bolts. (FIG 5)
- 9. Using an 8mm T-Handle or Socket, tighten the middle mounting bolts. (FIG 6)
- 10. Using a 4mm Allen Wrench, tighten the rear mounting bolts on the skidplate hook. (FIG 7)
- 11. Have fun and enjoy your next ride!
