12-4023 BETA RADIATOR GUARD

- 1. Remove the Seat
- 2. Using an 8mm T-Handle or Socket, remove the 4 bolts mounting the radiator shroud. It does not matter what side you start with. (FIG 1)
- 3. Remove the front OEM Radiator Louver by pressing the mounting tabs inward while pulling the louver outward. (FIG 2)
- 4. Using an 8mm T-Handle or Socket, remove the 2 radiator mounting bolts. You will no longer need these 2 bolts, but you will reuse the washers. (FIG 3)
- 5. Install one of the inner mounts labeled 12-4020-02. Using 2 of the supplied 6x16FBJ bolts into the radiator mounting holes you removed in step 4. The washers you saved from step 4, will go between the inner mount and the radiator tabs. Make sure the front guard mounting holes are facing forward. (FIG 4)
- 6. Using an 8mm T-Handle or Socket, tighten the bolts from step 5 to factory torque specs.
- 7. Install the correct side outer mount labeled 12-4023-03R or 03L depending on the right side or the left side. Use 2 of the supplied 6x16FBJ bolts and 2 of the supplied Flat washers. The bolt will mount from the inside to outside passing through the Louver mounting holes into the Outer mount. Tighten using a regular combination 8mm wrench. (FIG 5)
- 8. Install the correct side front guard plate labeled 12-4023-01R or 01L depending on the right side or the left side. Using 6 of the provided 5x12 socket head bolts mount the front plate to the Inner and outer brackets with the Enduro Engineering sticker facing outward. Start each of the 6 socket head bolts by hand, then tighten using a 4mm allen wrench. (FIG 6)
- 9. Repeat steps 2-8 for the opposite side.
- 10. Reinstall the shrouds. Use the supplied 6x16FBJ bolt and special flange washer in the lower mounting hole that threads into the outer mount. (FIG 7)
- 11. Reinstall the seat.
- 12. Have fun and enjoy your next ride!
