BETA RADIATOR GUARD INSTALLATION

Pick a side to start on, it does not matter which side is installed first.

- 1. Remove the seat.
- 2. Using an 8mm T-Handle or socket, remove the 4 bolts on the radiator shroud. (Keep these bolts, they will be reused) (FIG 1)
- 3. Remove radiator louver by pressing inward on the tabs while pulling outward on the louver.
- 4. Using an 8mm T-Handle or socket, remove the two radiator mounting bolts.
- 5. Line up the inside mount which is the smaller bracket labeled 12-4123-02, with the radiator mounting holes. Using the provided M6x16 flange bolts, mount the inside mount to the frame and radiator, tighten usings an 8mm T-Handle or socket. Make sure the threaded holes are facing forward. (FIG 2)
- 6. Line up the outside mount (12-4123-03L for left or 12-4123-03R for right) to the holes on the radiator that the louver tabs were located. Take the provided M6x16 flat head bolts and mount the outside mount to the radiator, use a 4mm Allen wrench to tighten. Make sure the threaded holes are facing forward. (FIG 3)
- 7. Line up the front plate (12-4123-01L for left or 12-4123-01R for right) to the threaded mounting holes on the inside and outside mounts with the Enduro Engineering sticker upright and facing outward. Using 6 of the provided M5x12 socket head bolts, thread them through the front plate and into the 3 threaded holes on both the outside and inside mounts. Make sure to have all 6 started by hand before tightening. (FIG 4) Tighten using a 4mm allen wrench. (FIG 5)
- 8. Reinstall the radiator shroud using the same 4 bolts removed in step 2.
- 9. Repeat the process on the opposite side.
- 10. Reinstall the seat.
- 11. Have fun and enjoy your next ride.
